The People's Choice Award will be presented at the end of the show to the artist who receives the most votes from attendees – we hope you will participate!

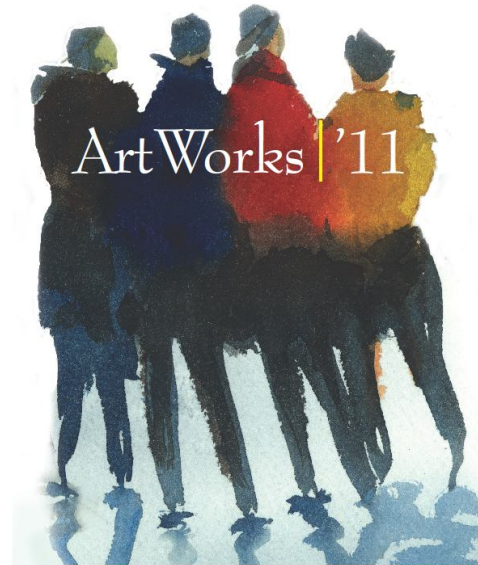

ELIGIBLE WORK:

- ✓ Brunswick Art Works members only, 18 years and older. **Paid memberships must be received by May 2, 2011 and will extend to May 31, 2012.**
- ✓ **ORIGINAL Drawings, Paintings, Photography and 3-Dimensional ONLY.** No copies of anyone else's work will be accepted.
- ✓ Artwork must not have been exhibited in ArtWorks '9 or ArtWorks'10 Exhibition.
- ✓ Three pieces per artist may be submitted; a triptych will be counted as three pieces.
- ✓ Exhibitor artists are asked to gallery sit for two hours during this exhibit.
- ✓ **Ruling about the eligibility of artwork is at the sole discretion of the exhibition committee.**

MAXIMUM SIZE:

- ✓ FRAMED: may not exceed 48" in any direction
- ✓ Simple, wired, ready to hang **NO SAWTOOTH HANGERS WILL BE ACCEPTED**
- ✓ Works on paper must be framed under glass or plexiglass.
- ✓ **ALL ARTWORK**, including 3-dimensional, must be easily handled by one person without assistance.
- ✓ Work requiring any repair will be declined.
