

**Polymer Clay Mokume Gane Bead with Nancy Shaw**  
Supply List

**Materials List** (available at any craft store):

clay - Sculpey Primo is preferred, but regular Sculpey or Fimo is alright, too.

↑ 2 two-ounce blocks of translucent or primo white translucent

↑ at least one 2-ounce block each of three coordinating colors that you like (not all dark colors, please!)

Acrylic roller with or without a handle.

Your own clay slicing blade is recommended, but there will be some to share.

(Note: The clay and roller should be less than \$15, and the clay is often on sale at craft stores.)
