

## Water Color for Scaredy Cats Supply List

### Items to be provided by student:

1. Photo reference if student chooses (not necessary) – may or may not use
2. Brushes – 1” flat and #8 round (either synthetic or synthetic/sable blend)\*
3. Support for paper (some sort of firm board, etc.) *at least* 14” x 18” One inexpensive option is to buy one piece of foam core (available at Pat Catan’s, Michael’s, or Hullo’s), cut two pieces to size, tape them together, and cover with contact paper (available at most grocery stores).
4. Paper towels
5. Tissues (without any lotion)
6. #2 lead pencil
7. White eraser or kneaded eraser
8. 1” masking tape

### The following items will be provided by the instructor\*:

1. Paper (Arches 140# cold-press)
2. Paint (6 colors of Winsor & Newton artist’s-quality watercolor)
3. Styrofoam plates (to be used as palettes)
4. Containers for water.
5. Table covers for work areas
6. Pump type spray bottles

\*These items are for use during workshop only and will not be taken home by students, except for watercolor paper that is used for paintings.

The following materials will also be provided for students to look at during the workshop:

- Art supply catalogs
- Watercolor magazines
- Self-help books on painting

\*Instructor will have some brushes available for use during the workshop, but it is suggested that students purchase their own brushes. These are the only two sizes that will be acceptable for this workshop.
